Construction of the Chelsea Recreation Center, located in the historic Chelsea area of Manhattan, was initiated over 30 years ago by the Department of Parks of the City of New York. Left incomplete during the fiscal crisis of the 1970's, a virtual shell of a building, it has remained barren until 2001, when the City of New York elected to complete the Center.

Our firm has been retained to restore the existing structure and complete the project as a comprehensive multipurpose recreation center. A new competition-sized pool and the state of the art gymnasium are the major amenities of this project, supplemented with a complete menu of meeting and seminar rooms, gymnasium facilities, locker rooms, and educational and art workshops studios and community facilities
